**Prof. Tony Attwood PhD** is an internationally recognised clinical psychologist, educator, and author. Recently featured on ABC's Australian Story, Tony is one of the world's foremost authorities on autism. His book *Asperger's Syndrome: A Guide for Parents and Professionals* is an international best seller and seminal in the field.



**Dr Michelle Garnett PhD** is a clinical psychologist who has specialised in autism for 27 years. In 2005 she founded Minds & Hearts, a now internationally recognised Clinic. Her research has informed understanding of early detection, the female profile and the importance of good mental health. She has co-authored five highly regarded books on autism. Her most recent book with Barb Cook is a seminal work on the female presentation, *Spectrum Women: Walking to the Beat of Autism*.
